

It is noted that Mrs. Baker is the daughter of Terri M. Crosby. To the best of Terri M. Crosby's knowledge, she had always assumed that Mrs. Baker had in fact notarized these forms and either her or her staff then mailed/faxed it in to the State of Louisiana, Office of Legislative Auditor, on behalf of Mrs. Crosby. It was not until October 11, 2013, that appearer, Terri Crosby, discovered that the four documents allegedly had not been signed/notarized by Mrs. Baker, prior to being submitted to the Office of Legislative Auditor.

Appearer hereby certifies under oath that she did not know that Notary Public, Tammy Anthony Baker is now alleging that she did not sign the four forms, nor does appearer, Mrs. Terri Crosby, know who actually signed as notary public on the submitted forms.

IT IS NOTED THAT ALL FINANCIAL INFORMATION ON THE FORMS SUBMITTED ON THE ABOVE DATES WAS TRUE AND ACCURATE, AND APPEARER DOES HEREBY RE-FILE, THESE FORMS TO CORRECT THE NOTARIZATION ISSUES ALLEGED.


**AFFIDAVIT**
